Introduction

Welcome to the 2026 Sponsorship Prospectus for the Newcastle University Women in Engineering (NUWiE) Society. We would like to thank you for your interest in sponsoring our society for 2026 and to all companies that have supported us over the past few years. The NUWiE sponsorship options have many benefits for companies.

NUWiE was established in 2014 as a support network for women in an educational space where they are underrepresented. Our numbers have grown each year despite only 23% of graduate engineers in Australia being women. In 2025, we reached 161 registered members with 289 event tickets sold, not including the Engineering Ball.

In 2025, our membership base was made up of the following degree types including, but not limited to: Civil (15%), Aerospace Systems (15%), Environmental (8%), Mechanical (7%), Electrical/Mechatronics (10%), Medical (5%), Chemical (5%), Software Engineering/IT/Computer Science/Data Analytics (8%), Renewable Energy (2%), Construction/Surveying/Architecture (6%), Science and other related fields (8%), and Postgraduate students within various disciplines (11%).

NUWiE is an affiliated club with the University of Newcastle Student Association (UNSA). NUWiE relies on volunteer executives, who dedicate their time and efforts to supporting and guiding their members. As such, any support of our organisation is greatly appreciated, and goes towards supporting diversity within engineering. Throughout 2026, we expect our club members will increase through attendance at NUWiE and collaborative club events. We are well-established in social media, sharing all of our event posts, past event photos, industry job opportunities and events with our followers.
